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The Tulalip Education Division and Tulalip Boys & Girls Club have converted youth facilities into Distance Learning sites for students. These sites are currently serving students in grades Kindergarten-12<sup>th</sup>. We are working with the Marysville School District and other entities to find creative ways to provide additional support during this time.

We understand the pandemic and school closures have caused unexpected hardships for families. Our goal is to support in the best way we can with the tools that we have. In order for our students to be successful with their Distance Education we must work in partnership with Parents/Guardians. With that, here is what the partnership will continue to look like while we are under a Distance Learning model:

**The Don Hatch Youth Center (6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>), Homework Support Program (K-5<sup>th</sup>) and the Boys & Girls Club (K-12<sup>th</sup>) facilities will provide:**

- Safe space for students to access internet and computers
- Staff support and guidance
- Daily Meals

**Parents/Guardian Responsibility:**

- Communicate with their student's teachers on a regular basis
- Make sure that your students arrive with Chromebook, charger, headphones & student log-in information
- No cell phones and video games during learning time
- Keep students home if they have any symptoms or have been exposed to anyone who is ill
- Students arrive on-time with a mask
- Understand that students may have homework and it is student/family responsibility to communicate with teachers and complete this work
- Parents/Guardians, give yourself time in the morning for student check-in

Our youth and their Education is a priority. We must work together to ensure a successful future for our children.
